(d) The Adjutant General, on May 1st of each year, shall submit to the Department of General Services and obtain approval of a schedule of rental, license, or lease fees for each state-owned or leased armory by location. This schedule, when approved by the Department of General Services, shall be used by the Adjutant General during the next succeeding fiscal year to determine the minimum rental, license, or lease fees to be charged the renter, licensee, or lessor.
