This report has been completed and is available on DGS' website. Recommend removal of this report requirement from the Legislative Counsel Bureau list.	The transportation sector is estimated to account for about forty percent of California's greenhouse gas emissions. The planning report in PRC Section 25722.8. was completed in 2009. However, DGS will continue to be required to generate updates on the State plan to reduce or displace the state fleet's consumption of petroleum products with alternative fuels, synthetic lubricants, and fuel-efficient vehicles and post them on their website until 2020. This date coincides with the State's AB 32 goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions to 1990 levels by 2020.
