0552	Quarterly Reports: Upon the completion of any review conducted by the Inspector General, he or she shall also prepare and issue on a quarterly basis a public report that includes all reviews completed in the previous quarter	Delete reporting requirement as the OIG is already required to publicly report each review at the time of its completion and then again annually. This language was pertinent when the OIG conducted dozens of "investigations" annually, but to require a report each quarter for only one or two reviews is fiscally burdensome on the OIG with no corresponding value.	The Office of the Inspector General issues a public report upon the completion of all reviews and then again annually. An additional quarterly report is not necessary.
