1	Report detailing the operation of the statewide Gang Violence Suppression Program and the results obtained by district attorneys' offices, local law enforcement agencies, county probation departments, school districts, county offices of education, and community-based organizations receiving funds from the program	Delete reporting requirement as the report has not been completed for 15 years and there are no known entities seeking this information. Note that the Gang Violence Suppression Program will be part of the Board of State and Community Corrections as of July 1, 2012.	The Legislative Analyst's Office recommends retaining this requirement until the Legislature determines what reporting is necessary for realignment grant oversight.
2	Report on prosecution of child abusers through specified techniques	Recommend delete the reporting requirement in the Penal Code and remove from LCB list as the information has been consolidated into the Joint Legislative Budget Committee Report.	The Legislative Analyst's Office contends that the data required in this report is not included in the JLBC quarterly report as indicated by CalEMA. The LAO recommends retaining this requirement.
3	Evaluation of the Child Abuser Prosecution Program identifying outcome measures to determine the effectiveness of the programs	Recommend delete reporting requirement in the Penal Code and remove from LCB list as the information has been consolidated into the Joint Legislative Budget Committee Report.	The Legislative Analyst's office contends that the data required in this report is not included in the JLBC quarterly report as indicated by CalEMA. The LAO recommends retaining this requirement.
4	Report on operation and accomplishments of program of financial assistance for statewide programs of education, training and research for local public prosecutors and public defenders	Recommend delete reporting requirement in Penal Code as this report is no longer relevant.	According to CalEMA, this reporting requirement is no longer relevant.
5	Operation and results of rural Indian crime prevention program	Recommend delete reporting requirement in Penal Code as this program no longer exists.	According to CalEMA, this program no longer exists.
6	Proposal for a funding allocation plan that links grant funding to the size of the problem of methamphetamines in each of five state-designated regions and a summary of spending by region, program activities, and demonstrated outcomes such a lab seizures and arrests	Recommend delete reporting requirement in the Penal Code as it was a one-time report.	The Legislature may wish to ask CalEMA if the reports required in the Budget Act were ever completed.
