This reporting requirement should be eliminated. SACPA funding was eliminated in 2009-10 and with it, the need to continue with evaluation reports as specified in the Act. The last SACPA evaluation was completed in 2009.	The CDADP recommends the elimination of this report requirement because the Substance Abuse Crime Prevention Act Evaluations (SACPA) program no longer exists, making the evaluation of the program no longer necessary. The last evaluation report of this program was completed in 2009.
