1	Adoption Assistance Program (AAP) & Aid to Families with Dependent Children-Foster Care Program Update (Department of Social Services & Department of Developmental Services provide a semiannual update on the changes made to the AAP & AFDC-FC Programs - Report # 08-1)	Recommend eliminating from Legislative Counsel list (or other source requirement) due to workload and limited resources. Data would still be available upon request.	According to the Department of Developmental Services, there is limited staff and funding available to complete this report but they will continue to make the information available upon request. The Alliance for Children’s Rights recommends keeping the report as it provides additional data in which to assess the impact that realignment is having on the overall functioning of our child welfare system.
2	Crisis Intervention for Persons with Developmental Disabilities (Reports on the status of MOUs between regional center's and county mental health agencies - Report #98-4)	Recommend eliminating as the report is not necessary. DDS maintains ongoing relationships with Department Mental Health.	The Department of Developmental Services recommends eliminating this report as DDS maintains “ongoing relationships” with the Department of Mental Health. According to the Alliance for Children’s Rights, the most recent report was published on May 26, 2010 and there are counties without the required MOUs in place. The Legislature may wish to keep this reporting requirement to ensure that those relationships are, in fact, being maintained.
