1	Administrative Efficiency Status Report (From 1999 to 2001, requires the department to appear before the Legislature and provide a status report on its efforts to achieve increased administrative efficiency.)	This reporting requirement should be eliminated. This was a limited-time requirement that was fulfilled.	According to the Department of Community Services and Development, this was a one-time report that was completed.
2	"Heat and Eat" Program. Should the demand for the nominal Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) service benefit exceed allocated funding established in the LIHEAP state plan, the DCSD and the DSS shall report to the Legislature and develop a plan to maintain the program as intended.)	This reporting requirement should be eliminated. This issue can be discussed at budget hearings if this specific situation occurs. Note: This same report is also listed under the Department of Social Services (Org 5180).	According to the Department of Community Services and Development, the report should be deleted and could be more properly reviewed during a budget hearing. The report is only required when the demand for the nominal LIHEAP service benefit exceeds allocated funding established by the CSD in the LIHEAP state plan.  (Note: This report is also listed in the spreadsheet under DSS (5180).
