DURING THE 2015-16 CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

**AB 12 (Cooley) State government: administrative regulations: review**

Requires state agencies and departments to review, adopt, amend or repeal any applicable regulations that are duplicative, overlapping, inconsistent, or out of date.

Last Action: Held in Senate Appropriations Committee

**AB 80 (Campos) Interagency Task Force on the Status of Boys and Men of Color**

Establishes the 20-Member Interagency Task Force on the Status of Boys and Men of Color within state government.

Last Action: Veto

**AB 166 (Beth Gaines) Department of General Services**

Authorizes the Department of General Services, with consent from the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, to enter into a long-term lease for land on the grounds of the California State Prison at Folsom for a non-state funded peace officers memorial and museum.

Last Action: Chapter 211, Statutes of 2015

**AB 229 (Chang) State employees: travel reimbursement**

Prevents state agencies from prohibiting state employees traveling on official state business from using transportation network companies or lodging in short-term rentals.

Last Action: Chapter 770, Statutes of 2015

**AB 255 (Irwin) Veterans: Internal Audits for Veterans Affairs**

Creates the office of Internal Audits for Veterans Affairs within the California Department of Veterans Affairs, in which the chief auditor would be appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 351 (Jones-Sawyer) Public contracts: small business participation**

Requires each state agency to establish and achieve a goal of 25% small business participation.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 354 (A&AR Committee) Director of General Services: state leases: notification**

Requires the Director of the Department of General Services to notify the chairperson of the Assembly Committee on Accountability and Administrative Review and the Senate Committee on Governmental Organization of a pending building lease when that lease is for a period of five years or longer and an annual rental in excess of \$10,000.

Last Action: Inactive file on Senate Floor

**AB 362 (Waldron) State printing: demonstration project: process free printing**

Allows the Department of General Services to engage in a sustainable practices pilot printing program that could be funded by a participating vendor.

Last Action: Veto

**AB 410 (Obernolte) Reports submitted to legislative committees**

Requires a state agency to post on its Web site a report the state agency is required by law to submit to a committee of the Legislature.

Last Action: Veto

**AB 429 (Dahle) Public contracts: preferences: forest products**

Establishes a bid preference for state contracts for lumber and other solid wood products harvested in compliance with the Z'berg-Nejedly Forest Practice Act, federal timber sales, or a federal certification program identified by the director of the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection.

Last Action: Veto

**AB 435 (Chang) Resource Agency: Web casts of public meetings and workshops**

Requires the California Environmental Protection Agency and Natural Resources Agency to webcast all public meetings and to include methods for remote participation.

Last Action: Held in Senate Appropriations Committee

**AB 522 (Burke) Public contracts: information technology: contractor performance assessment report**

Requires the Director of the Department of Technology (CDT) to develop a standardized contractor performance assessment report system to evaluate the performance of a contractor on any information technology contract or project reportable to CDT.

Last Action: Veto

**AB 532 (McCarty) State agencies: collection of data: race or ethnic origin**

Requires state entities that collect demographic information on ethnicity and race to provide forms that offer respondents the option of selecting one or more ethnic or racial designations, by January 1, 2022.

Last Action: Chapter 433, Statutes of 2015

**AB 552 (O'Donnell) Public works contracts: damages**

Limits the scope of consequential damages arising from a breach of a public works contract to cover only “delay damages,” defined as damages incurred by a public agency for each day after the date on which the work was to be completed by the contractor pursuant to the public works contract.

Last Action: Chapter 434, Statutes of 2015

**AB 558 (Low) Public contracts: state contracts: information technology goods and services**

Requires the Department of Technology and Department of General Services to use electronic means whenever possible to post documents and receive bids when conducting information technology procurements.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 581 (Gomez) State Facilities: Renewal Bond Act of 2016**

Authorizes the issuance of \$2 billion in general obligation bonds for deferred maintenance projects on state-owned buildings, if approved by the voters at the June 7, 2016, statewide primary election.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 606 (Levine) Water conservation**

Requires state agencies to reduce water consumption and increase water efficiencies when building on state-owned real property, purchasing real property, or replacing landscaping or irrigation, where feasible, and provides an exemption for state property that is leased to a private party for agricultural purposes.

Last Action: Chapter 665, Statutes of 2015

**AB 692 (Quirk) Low-carbon transportation fuels**

Requires each state agency that is a buyer of transportation fuels to buy 3% of very low carbon transportation fuels, as defined, beginning January 1, 2017, increasing by 1% per year thereafter until 2024.

Last Action: Chapter 588, Statutes of 2015

**AB 706 (Bonilla) California Volunteers**

Establishes the California AmeriCorps Science, Technology, Engineering and Math program in state government.

Last Action: Veto

**AB 728 (Hadley) State government: financial reporting**

Requires state agencies to post their State Leadership Accountability Act reports, which assess their internal controls and monitoring practices, on their Web sites after acceptance by the Department of Finance.

Last Action: Chapter 371, Statutes of 2015

**AB 760 (O'Donnell) Department of General Services: local educational agencies: portable electronic equipment**

Requires the Department of General Services to seek bids for the purchase of portable electronic equipment and to establish a process for local educational agencies to purchase the equipment under terms negotiated by the department.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**AB 797 (Steinorth) Regulations: effective dates and legislative review**

Requires a copy of each major regulation submitted to the Secretary of State by the Office of Administrative Law to also be submitted to the appropriate Legislative policy committees responsible for the subject matter of the regulation for review.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 805 (Burke) Director of Technology: procurement: training program**

Requires the Department of Technology, in cooperation with the Department of General Services, to establish and implement an information technology procurement training program and curriculum.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 814 (Daly) Tax information: administration**

Requires the Franchise Tax Board, the State Board of Equalization, and the Employment Development Department to conduct a feasibility study on the development of a single Internet Web-based portal that would essentially consolidate the three agencies.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Rev & Tax Committee

**AB 843 (Hadley) Controller: Internet Web site**

Requires the State Controller to publish on its website local governments' financial transactions and compensation information in a format that can be searched, printed, and downloaded.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**AB 959 (Chiu) Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender Disparities Reduction Act**

Requires the Department of Health Care Services, the Department of Public Health, the Department of Social Services, and the Department of Aging to collect voluntary self-identification information on sexual orientation and gender identity, beginning no later than July 1, 2018, when collecting demographic data.

Last Action: Chapter 565, Statutes of 2015

**AB 975 (Frazier) Local Agency Public Construction Act: bid criteria**

Prohibits public agencies from disqualifying or penalizing prospective bidders based on bidders' involvement in specified types of claims.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 1011 (O'Donnell) State Property: Los Angeles**

Requires the California Department of Transportation to transfer specified vacant real property to the City of Los Angeles for park purposes, subject to various terms and conditions.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 1050 (Low) State employees: charitable deductions**

Requires a charitable organization seeking to participate in the state employees' charitable giving program to provide a statement to the program administrator certifying that it complies with existing civil rights and nondiscrimination laws.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 1215 (Ting) California Open Data Standard**

Establishes the position of Chief Data Officer in state government and creates the California Open Data Standard for state agencies to make public data available on an Internet Web portal.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 1218 (Weber) Public contracts: disabled veteran business enterprise**

Makes various changes to the statewide disabled veteran business enterprises contracting program administered by the Department of General Services.

Last Action: Held in Senate Appropriations Committee

**AB 1281 (Wilk) Regulations: legislative review**

Requires that when 25% of the members of the Assembly or Senate transmit to the Governor their written declaration of opposition to a proposed regulation, the adoption of that regulation must require a majority vote of both houses.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**AB 1294 (Holden) State government: prompt payment of claims**

Increases the gross receipts threshold for small businesses and nonprofit organizations that provide Medi-Cal health care services to a level that could increase the number of providers who are subject to the California Prompt Payment Act, which sets penalties when a state agency does not pay in a timely manner.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**AB 1302 (Brown) Public Contracts: disabled veterans**

Increases the annual statewide participation goal for disabled veteran business enterprises, applicable to certain state contracts, from 3% to 5%.

Last Action: Held in JEDE Committee

**AB 1347 (Chiu) Public contracts: claims**

Establishes a claims resolution process, which excludes several state entities, for public works contracts by which a general contractor may seek public agency review of the claim.

Last Action: Veto

**AB 1405 (Grove) Developmental centers: closure**

Requires the Department of Developmental Services to close the Fairview and Sonoma Developmental Centers and directs the Director of the Department of General Services to, upon the closures, lease all or part of the parcels, as specified.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 1445 (Brown) Public contracts: small business contracts**

Increases the amount for which a state agency can directly contract with a certified small business or a disabled veteran business enterprise from \$250,000 to \$500,000.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 1566 (Wilk) Reports**

Requires written reports submitted to the Legislature or executive body, by any state agency or department, to include a signed statement by the head of that agency or department declaring that the factual contents of the report are true, accurate and complete to the best of his/her knowledge.

Last Action: Failed in A&AR Committee

**AB 1648 (Wilk) State publications: distribution**

Expands the definition of “state publication” to include publications that are issued by the state on the internet and allows a member of the public to copy, share, distribute, or republish as specified.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 1765 (Irwin) California Volunteers: nonprofit public benefit corporation**

Authorizes California Volunteers, a program within the Governor’s Office, to form a tax-exempt public benefit nonprofit corporation for fundraising purposes, as specified, and prohibits the nonprofit public benefit corporation from using more than 10% of the grants and financial support it receives for its own administrative costs.

Last Action: Chapter 743, Statutes of 2016

**AB 1840 (Irwin) California State Auditor**

Requires the State Auditor to obtain approval from the Joint Legislative Audit Committee prior to conducting any work at a local government agency.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 1868 (Wagner) Regulations: legislative notice**

Requires state agencies to submit a proposed regulatory action to the Legislature if the proposed action includes an economic or cost impact.

Last Action: Failed in Assembly Appropriations Committee



**AB 1873 (Holden) Office of Planning and Research: Board of Infrastructure Planning, Development, and Finance**

Creates the Board of Infrastructure Planning, Development, and Finance within the Strategic Growth Council.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 1880 (Irwin) State real property: reversion**

Authorizes the Director of the Department of General Services to revert a specified parcel of state real property to the City of San Buenaventura in Ventura County.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 1887 (Low) State government: discrimination: travel**

Prohibits, with some exceptions, a state agency and the Legislature from requiring its employees to travel to states that discriminate on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expressions, or approving state-funded travel to such states.

Last Action: Chapter 687, Statutes of 2016

**AB 1955 (Wilk) State contracts: information technology goods and services: cybersecurity insurance**

Requires a state agency that procures information technology goods or services to give a preference to vendors who carry cybersecurity insurance.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**AB 1991 (Jones) State agencies: award of contracts: noncompetitive bid basis**

Requires state agencies to notify the Legislature when seeking a noncompetitive bid contract for \$1 million or more and delays contract adoption until 90 days after the notification.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**AB 2033 (Wilk) Code of Regulations: distribution**

Requires the Office of State Printing to file the California Code of Regulations and its updates with a librarian in charge of the county library or county law library in each county, where the documents must be made available to the public.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**AB 2180 (Ting) Fair Employment and Housing Council: reports**

Expedites timelines for approval or disapproval by a public agency for certain types of development projects.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 2203 (Eggman) Department of Customer Service: establishment**

Establishes a new Department of Customer Service within the Government Operations Agency.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**AB 2204 (Eggman) Office of Digital Services: establishment**

Establishes a new Office of Digital Services within a new Department of Customer Service in state government.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**AB 2247 (Williams) Armories**

Requires the Director of the Department of General Services, with the approval of the Adjutant General of the Military Department, to grant specified cities and school districts the option to purchase specified armories.

Last Action: Chapter 382, Statutes of 2016

**AB 2270 (Bonta) Public contracts: business development: statewide bonding program**

Establishes a statewide contractor bonding program within the Department of General Services.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 2358 (Bigelow) Public contracts: small business contracts**

Increases the maximum amount for which a state agency can directly contract with a certified small business or a disabled veteran business enterprise from \$250,000 to \$300,000.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 2452 (Quirk) California Council on Science and Technology: contracting**

Allows state entities to enter into noncompetitive contracts that are exempt from state contracting procedures with the California Council on Science and Technology for work to explain scientific studies in order to inform public policy.

Last Action: Referred to Committee after last scheduled bill hearing and was not heard

**AB 2543 (Gordon) State buildings: efficiency and conservation**

Assigns primary responsibility for developing a multi-year energy efficiency plan for state facilities to the California Energy Commission, instead of the Department of General Services, and expands the scope of the plan to include water conservation.

Last Action: Held in Senate Appropriations Committee

**AB 2557 (Santiago) State contracts: nondiscrimination clause**

Deletes provisions in current law that allow a city or county to adopt an interim emergency ordinance that has the effect of denying approvals needed for the development of projects with a significant component of multifamily housing, and makes existing law relating to the ability of a city or county to enact emergency and interim ordinances applicable to charter cities.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**AB 2674 (Bonta) State archives: Online Archives Program**

Establishes the Online Archives Program under the Secretary of State's State Archives to allow for online access of records, photographs, exhibits, and other items held by the State Archives.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 2711 (Chiu) Pharmaceuticals: purchasing**

Reinstates a previously repealed requirement for the Department of General Services to report to the Legislature on its prescription drug bulk purchasing program.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**AB 2844 (Bloom) Public contracts: California Combating the Boycott Divestment, and Sanctions of Israel Act of 2016**

Requires a contractor seeking to enter into, or renew, a state contract with a value of \$100,000 or more to certify under penalty of perjury that they are complying with the state's existing anti-discrimination laws and to certify that any policy that they have adopted against a sovereign nation or peoples recognized by the U.S. government is not used to discriminate in violation of the state's anti-discrimination laws.

Last Action: Chapter 581, Statutes of 2016

**AB 2904 (A&AR) State real property: surplus**

Authorizes the Director of the Department of General Services to dispose of specified surplus property and rescinds the prior surplus authorization of a specified parcel.

Last Action: Chapter 207, Statutes of 2016

**ACR 153 (Burke) California Council on Science and Technology**

Urges the California Council on Science and Technology to place an emphasis on selecting fellows who are reflective of the state's diversity, specifically regarding race, ethnicity, and socioeconomic status.

Last Action: Held in A&AR Committee

**ALL SENATE BILLS

DURING THE 2015-16 CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

**SB 10 (Lara) Immigration: Governor's Office of New Americans**

Establishes the Office of New Americans in the Governor's office for the purpose of, among other things, coordinating an ongoing multiagency, multisector public and private effort to provide information and services to new Americans.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**SB 255 (Liu) State government: Commission on the Status of Women and Girls**

Authorizes the Commission on the Status of Women and Girls to conduct fundraising activities that charge an admission price; exempts Commission meetings conducted solely for fundraising purposes from the Bagley Keene Open Meeting Act; and, makes a clarifying change to the composition of the Commission.

Last Action: Chapter 574, Statutes of 2015

**SB 273 (Hueso) State real property: surplus**

Authorizes the Department of General Services to dispose of two specified surplus state properties.

Last Action: Chapter 233, Statutes of 2015

**SB 376 (Lara) Public contracts: University of California**

Requires a contractor with the University of California (UC) to qualify as a lowest responsible bidder or best value awardee on any contract for specified services to certify that the contractor's employees receive a total employee compensation package that does not materially undercut the average per-employee value of total compensation if UC was to pay its employees to do comparable work.

Last Action: Veto

**SB 536 (Roth) Armories**

Allows the Department of General Services with the approval of the Adjutant General of the California Military Department to sell seven specified armory properties and sets terms for how the costs of the sales will be paid.

Last Action: Chapter 355, Statutes of 2015

**SB 573 (Pan) Statewide open data portal**

Establishes the position of Chief Data Officer (CDO) in state government and requires the CDO to create a publically-accessible statewide open data portal by January 1, 2017.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**SB 680 (Wieckowski) State real property: surplus: City of Santa Clara**

Authorizes the Director of the Department of General Services to modify the existing terms and conditions governing the sale and transfer of a parcel of state surplus property within the City of Santa Clara to the Santa Clara Housing Authority.

Last Action: Chapter 649, Statutes of 2016

**SB 703 (Leno) Public contracts: prohibitions: discrimination**

Prohibits a state agency from entering into contracts for the acquisition of goods or services of \$100,000 or more with a contractor that discriminates between employees on the basis of gender identity in the provision of benefits.

Last Action: Chapter 578, Statutes of 2015

**SB 786 (Allen) Advance technology parking incentive programs: reports**

Requires the existing progress report prepared by the Department of General Services relative to fleet vehicles to also include a progress report on developing and implementing the advanced technology parking incentive programs.

Last Action: Amended out of the Committee's jurisdiction

**SB 959 (Lara) University of California: contracts: bidding**

Modifies the requirements for qualifying as a lowest responsible bidder or best value awardee for contracts for specified types of service contracts at the University of California (UC) by requiring a bidder to certify in writing that its employees are compensated at a level that does not undercut, by more than five percent, the average per-employee value of total compensation for UC employees who perform comparable work.

Last Action: Veto

**SB 1012 (Nguyen) Flags: purchase**

Requires State and local governments that purchase any flag of the United States or flag of the State of California to purchase ones made in the United States.

Last Action: Chapter 717, Statutes of 2016

**SB 1120 (Wolk) Director of General Services: state medical facilities: leases**

Allows the Director of the Department of General Services to renew existing lease agreements with the Napa and Solano County Offices of Education for the operation of special needs and alternative education programs on land located within the grounds of Napa State Hospital and the Medical Facility at Vacaville, respectively.

Last Action: Chapter 482, Statutes of 2016

**SJR 16 (DeLeón) AmeriCorps**

Urges Congress to protect and sustain full funding for the Corporation for National and Community Service, the federal agency that administers various national service programs, including AmeriCorps.

Last Action: Chapter 165, Statutes of 2015
