Report submitted to Legislature in November 1981 detailing total costs to complete project of surveying entire coast.	This report was completed and submitted to the Legislature in 1981. Existing law does not require this report to be updated once completed.
2	Report on actions taken and reasons therefore, after reviewing and considering, California Coastal Commission's recommendations that include changes in administrative regulations, rules, and statutes designed to encourage the agency to carry out its functions in a manner consistent with the protection of the state's natural and scenic resources so that inland and coastal resources are preserved, including comments on any legislation that may have been proposed by the California Coastal Commission	Delete Reporting Requirement. Coordination of this activity more appropriate to Natural Resources Agency Secretary.	This provision of the Coastal Act, requires the State Lands Commission and departments within the Resources Agency to report on actions taken after reviewing the Coastal Commission recommendations. The State Lands Commission suggests that coordination of this activity is more appropriate for the Resources Agency. The Legislature may wish to consider retaining this requirement until a specific proposal supported by all the affected departments is submitted.
3	Report on a schedule for expenditures for disbursement of moneys from the Oil Trust Fund to the City of Long Beach	Delete Reporting Requirement. One time only requirement. Requirement met in 2007. No further reporting required.	This one-time report was completed and submitted in 2007.
