1	Schedule of Rental/License/Lease Fees for National Guard Armories MVC §431 refers to the leasing, rental or licensing of an armory. Subsection (d) states the Adjutant General shall submit to (and obtain approval) from the Department of General Services a schedule of rental, license, or lease fees for each state-owned or lease armory by location	Delete reporting requirement as rental and licensing of armories is governed by Army National Guard Regulation; all armory leases must be submitted to and approved by Department of General Services.	The California Military Department is required to submit this rental and licensing information regarding armories to the Department of General Services, who approves all armory leases.
2	Construction Projects - Contracting Methods MVC §434 refers to the Adjutant General's authority to lease and construct armories required for National Guard military purposes. Subsection 434(c)(2) states the Adjutant General shall make findings in writing regarding the contracting methods used when carrying out provisions of §434(b) and to provide these findings to Department of General Services annually	Delete reporting requirement as the Military Department has independent authority to contract for construction projects.	The Legislature may wish to consider whether the Department of General Services should continue receiving construction project contracting reports from the Military Department.
