YEAR END 2021-22 CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

AB 2 (Fong) Regulations: Legislative Review: Regulatory Reform

Requires each state agency to conduct a one-time review of all of its regulations and make specified changes on or before January 1, 2023.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

AB 46 (L. Rivas) California Youth Empowerment Act

Establishes the California Youth Empowerment Commission, with the goal of providing opportunities for civic engagement to improve the quality of life for California's disconnected and disadvantaged youth.

Last Action: Chapter 660, Statutes of 2021

AB 49 (Petrie-Norris) California Debt Limit Allocation Committee: elimination and allocation of duties

Last Action: Re-referred out of Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 343 (Fong) California Public Records Act Ombudsperson

Establishes a California Public Records Act Ombudsperson within the California State Auditor's Office to review California Public Records Act requests denied by state agencies.

Last Action: Held in Senate Governmental Organization Committee

AB 412 (Reyes) California Commission on Human Rights

Establishes the California Commission on Human Rights to identify and evaluate the State's efforts in protecting human rights, and develop an annual report to the California State Legislature and Governor.

Last Action: Vetoed 10/08/2021

AB 416 (Kalra) California Deforestation-Free Procurement Act: public works projects: wood and wood products

Requires entities that contract with the state for a forest-risk commodity, on or after 2024, to certify Department of General Services that the products supply chain does not contribute to tropical deforestation.

Last Action: Vetoed 10/05/2021

AB 564 (L. Gonzalez) Biodiversity Protection and Restoration Act

Requires all state agencies, boards and commissions to consider and prioritize the protection of biodiversity in carrying out their statutory mandates.

Last Action: Held in Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 581 (Irwin) Cybersecurity

Requires all state agencies to review and implement guidelines published by the National Institute of Standards and Technology or derived therefrom, for reporting, coordinating, publishing, and receiving information about security vulnerabilities of state information technology systems and resolving those vulnerabilities.

Last Action: Held in Senate Appropriation Committee

AB 661 (Bennett) Recycling: Materials

Makes numerous changes to the Buy Recycled Campaign and requires state agencies to purchase recycled products instead of non-recycled products whenever recycled products are available.

Last Action: Chapter 517, Statutes of 2022

AB 683 (Grayson) Recycling: Procurement

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 777 (McCarty) State property: Transfer: University of California

Authorizes the Department of General Services to transfer, without cost, a parcel of land located at, 4949 Broadway in the City of Sacramento, to the Regents of the University of California for the University of California, Davis Medical Center to construct below local market rate rental housing for faculty, staff and students.

Last Action: Vetoed 09/28/2022

AB 778 (E. Garcia) Institutional Purchasers: Purchase of California-Grown Agricultural Food Products

Requires a California state-owned or state-run institution that purchases agricultural food products to implement necessary practices to achieve a goal of at least 60% of the agricultural food products are grown or produced in the state by December 31, 2025.

Last Action: Chapter 576, Statutes of 2022

AB 782 (Cooper) Congo Child Labor Act of 2021

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 809 (Irwin) Information Security

Requires state agencies that are not under the direct authority of the Governor to adopt and implement certain federal and national information security and privacy policies, standards, and procedures.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

AB 833 (Quirk-Silva) State Government: Grants: Administrative Costs

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 884 (Patterson) State Agencies: Audits

Requires all state agencies with an aggregate spending of \$50,000,000 or more annually to establish an ongoing audit function.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriation Committee

AB 893 (Davies) Emergency Regulations: Division of Occupational Safety and Health: State Department of Public Health

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 923 (Ramos) Government-to-Government Consultation Act: State-Tribal Consultation: Training

Encourages the state and its agencies to consult on a government-to-government basis with federally recognized, and with non-federally recognized tribes, in order to allow tribal officials the opportunity to provide meaningful input in the development of policies, processes, programs, and projects that have tribal implications.

Last Action: Chapter 475, Statutes of 2022

AB 934 (Cooley) Public Buildings: Shelter in Place: Guidelines

Requires the Department of General Services, to prepare and submit a report to the Joint Rules Committee by March 1, 2022 summarizing Federal Emergency Management safety guidelines related to the integration of shelter-in-place facilities in public buildings.

Last Action: Chapter 174, Statutes of 2021

AB 1025 (R. Rivas) Institutional Purchasers: Purchase of Domestic Agricultural Food Products

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 1126 (Bloom) Commission on the State of Hate

Establishes the Commission on the State of Hate to provide policy recommendations and public resources to respond to and reduce hate crimes.

Last Action: Chapter 712, Statutes of 2021

AB 1323 (Haney) Alcoholic beverage control: tied-house exceptions

Allows specified licensees to purchase advertising space and time from, or on behalf of, an on-sale licensee that is the owner, manager, or major tenant of an on-sale retail licensed premises configured with theatrical seating of at least 1,600 seats but no more than 2,400 sets in the city and County of San Francisco (Curran Theatre)

Last Action: This bill was subsequently amended to address a different subject matter. Chapter 271, Statutes of 2022

AB 1358 (Muratsuchi) Demographics: Ancestry and Ethnic Origins

Expands the groups that specified state agencies are required to collect disaggregated demographic data on and requires the California Department of Public Health establish standards for the collection of demographic information by local health officers and healthcare providers.

Last Action: Held in Senate Appropriations Committee

AB 1365 (Bonta) Public Contracts: Clean Concrete

Establishes a schedule to incorporate concrete into the Buy Clean program and leverage California's purchasing power to advance low carbon technologies and best practices across the supply chain.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Natural Resources Committee

AB 1369 (Bennett) Buy Clean California Act: Eligible Materials: Product-Specific Global Warming Potential Emissions

Expands the Buy Clean California Act by adding products with a high potential of carbon reductions and authorizes the Department of General Services to add eligible materials as data becomes available in more product/material categories.

Last Action: Ordered to inactive file at the request of Senator Becker

AB 1397 (E. Garcia) Public Contracts: California Lithium Economy Act

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 1429 (Holden) State Agency Records: Records Management Coordinator Duties: Personnel Training

Increases the required training for state agency personnel who work with public records on behalf of the agency.

Last Action: Held in Senate Appropriations Committee

AB 1481 (Patterson) The Financial Information System for California: the California State Auditor's Office's Annual Report.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 1571 (Committee on Jobs, Economic Development, and the Economy) Administrative Procedure Act: Small Businesses

Requires state agencies to include certain findings when developing a regulation impacting a small business located in an area declared to be in a state of emergency.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

AB 1600 (Nguyen) California Commission on the United States Semiquincentennial

Establishes the California Commission on the United States Semiquincentennial to plan and coordinate commemorations and observances of the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence and the founding of the United States of America.

Last Action: Held in Senate Appropriation Committee

AB 1776 (Gallagher) Resource Conservation Districts: California Prompt Payment Act

Makes resource conservation districts eligible for specified late payment penalties, pursuant to the state's Prompt Payment Act, when state agencies are delinquent in making contract payments.

Last Action: Chapter 455, Statutes of 2022

AB 1804 (Salas) Financial Information System for California

Requires the Financial Information System for California project office to include specified information in its annual report to the Legislature.

Last Action: Vetoed 09/23/2022

AB 1806 (Salas) Public Contracts: information technology: Department of Technology: modular contracting

Requires the California Department of Technology develop a process by which it will maximize the use of modular contracting for large-scale information technology acquisitions.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

AB 1979 (Kalra) California Deforestation-Free Procurement Act: Public Works Projects: wood and wood products.

Establishes the California Deforestation-Free Procurement Act and requires entities that contract with the state for forest-risk products to certify to the Department of General Services that the product's supply chain does not contribute to tropical deforestation or intact forest degradation.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 1983 (Fong) Department of General Services: Best Value Procurement: Vehicles and Equipment.

Requires the Department of General Services to use the best value procurement method to purchase and equip heavy mobile fleet vehicles and special equipment for use by the Department of Transportation.

Last Action: Vetoed 09/23/2022

AB 1996 (Cooley) State Government: Administrative Regulations: Review

Requires each state entity to review of all its regulations and identify and revise any that are duplicative, overlapping, inconsistent, or out of date by January 1, 2026.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

AB 2112 (Nguyen) Regulations: Economic Impact Report

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 2135 (Irwin) Information Security

Requires state agencies that are not under the direct authority of the Governor to adopt and implement certain federal and national information security and privacy policies, standards, and procedures.

Last Action: Chapter 773, Statutes of 2022

AB 2173 (Petrie-Norris) Public Contracts: Payment

Removes the sunset clause on the 5 % retention cap policy related to public works projects, thereby permanently establishing it.

Last Action: Chapter 121, Statutes of 2022

AB 2233 (Quirk-Silva) Excess State Land: Development of Affordable Housing

Requires the Department of General Services to develop a plan to facilitate development of affordable housing on state-owned excess land.

Last Action: Chapter 438, Statutes of 2022

AB 2439 (Bloom) State Property: Department of Motor Vehicles Field Offices: Affordable Housing

Requires Department of Motor Vehicles to lease, as specified, three active DMV field offices to affordable housing developers for the construction of new DMV field offices and affordable housing.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

AB 2454 (Jones-Sawyer) Public Contracts: Protests: Joint Labor Management Committee

Authorizes a joint labor-management committee to submit a specified protest to a state public works contracts that is not to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder.

Last Action: Held in Senate Governmental Organization Committee

AB 2592 (McCarty) Housing: Underutilized State Buildings

Requires underutilized state buildings and surplus state lands be identified and transitioned into housing.

Last Action: Chapter 439, Statutes of 2022

AB 2600 (M. Dahle) State Agencies: Letters and Notices

Last Action: Held in Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

AB 2885 (Petrie-Norris) State Property: Fairview Developmental Center

Directs the Department of General Services to sell, lease, or transfer 10 acres of property from the Fairview Developmental Center Project in Costa Mesa to the Office of Emergency Services to construct an emergency management center.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

AB 2893 (Daly) Administrative Procedure Act: Standardized Regulatory Impact Analysis: comments, updates, and format

Requires a state agency, when preparing a standardized regulatory impact analysis, to take an additional 30 days of public comment each time the proposed major regulation is updated and revise its analysis to reflect any additional comments received from the Department of Finance.

Last Action: Held in Senate Appropriations Committee

AB 2900 (Patterson) The Financial Information System for California: California State Auditor's Office

Requires the California Auditor to annually monitor the contract for independent project oversight and independent verification and validation services for the FISCal system.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

**ALL SENATE BILLS
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YEAR END 2021-22 CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

SB 17 (Pan) Racial Equity Commission

Establishes the Office of Racial Equity, governed by a Racial Equity Advisory and Accountability Council, to develop a statewide Racial Equity Framework in consultation with state agencies.

Last Action: Ordered to inactive file on request of Assembly Member Reyes

SB 34 (Umberg) Public Contracts: Authorized Agent: Limitations

voids a contract that was entered into because of a violation of anti-corruption laws for public agents.

Last Action: Chapter 297, Statutes of 2022

SB 543 (Limon) Department of General Services: Nonprofit Liaison

Requires a state agency that significantly regulates or impacts nonprofit corporations to designate a nonprofit liaison.

Last Action: Vetoed 09/27/2022

SB 551 (Stern) California Zero- Emission Vehicle Authority

Establishes the California Electric Vehicle Authority within the Governor's office to advance electric vehicle and zero-emission charging infrastructure by coordinating with state, regional, and local government entities.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriation Committee

SB 561 (Dodd) State Surplus Property: Digital Inventory: Affordable Housing

Requires the Department of General Services to develop criteria to evaluate the suitability of state-owned parcels determined or declared excess to be used for affordable housing.

Last Action: Chapter 446, Statutes of 2022

SB 702 (Limon) Gubernatorial Appointments: Report

Requires the Governor to publish a report containing demographics information of individuals appointed to state boards and commissions.

Last Action: Vetoed 01/27/2022

SB 778 (Becker) Buy Clean California Act: Environmental Product Declarations: Concrete

Adds concrete to the Buy Clean California Act, requiring a successful project bidder to provide global warming potential of each concrete product used.

Last Action: Failed Passage from Assembly Accountability and Administrative Review Committee

SB 828 (Governmental Organization) Surplus State Real Property: Disposal

Authorizes the Department of General Services to dispose of surplus state property.

Last Action: Chapter 189, Statutes of 2021

SB 911 (Glazer) State Government: California Board to Fund Public Interest Media
Enacts the California Public Media Interest Media Act of 2022, which establishes the California Board to Fund Public Interest Media and the California Fund for Public Interest Media to encourage independent, local public service news coverage, and awarding grants to individuals or organizations.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

SB 1010 (Skinner) Air Pollution: State Vehicle Fleet

Requires the Department of General Services to develop criteria to evaluate bidders for commercial rental car services contracts based in part on the number of ZEVs in their rental car fleet.

Last Action: Chapter 360, Statutes of 2022

SB 1069 (Umberg) State Grant Programs: Negotiated Cost Rate Agreements

Requires the Department of General Services to establish a state standard negotiated cost agreement for awarding state grants to grantees that do not have an existing Negotiated Indirect Cost Rate Agreement.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

SB 1192 (Ochoa Bogh) Public Contracts: Withheld Payments

Clarifies that the term “contractor” includes design professionals for the purposes of authorizing the substitution of alternative securities in lieu of retention payments withheld when contracting with a state agency on a public works project.

Last Action: Chapter 93, Statutes of 2022

SB 1203 (Becker) Net-Zero Emissions of Greenhouse Gases: State Agency Operations

Declares the intent of the Legislature that state agencies are to achieve zero net emissions of greenhouse gases resulting from their operations no later than January 1, 2035.

Last Action: Chapter 368, Statutes of 2022

SB 1216 (Gonzalez) Secretary of Government Operations: Deepfakes

Requires the Secretary of the Government Operations Agency to establish, upon appropriation by the Legislature, the Deepfake Working Group to evaluate, among other things, the impact the proliferation of deepfakes has on government, business, and residents of the state.

Last Action: Chapter 885, Statutes of 2022

SB 1251 (Gonzalez) Governor’s Office of Business and Economic Development: Zero-Emission Vehicle Market Development Office: Zero-Emission Vehicle Equity Advocate

Formalizes the current Zero-Emission Vehicle Market Development Office and adds the position of Zero-Emission Equity Advocate within the Governor’s Office of Business and Economic Development.

Last Action: Chapter 372, Statutes of 2022

SB 1271 (Wilk) Contracts for the Acquisition of Goods or Services: Extension or Renewal: Legislative Oversight

Requires a state agency, for a contract awarded without competitive bidding for the acquisition of goods or services in the amount of \$75 million or more, entered into on or after January 1, 2023, to submit information regarding the terms or conditions of a proposed extension or renewal of the contract to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee.

Last Action: Chapter 543, Statutes of 2022

SB 1305 (Laird) State Vehicle Fleet: Alternative Fuel Vehicles

Requires the Department of General Services to maximize the purchase and availability of alternative fuel vehicles in the state vehicle fleet by adopting a procurement method to evaluate those vehicles.

Last Action: Chapter 152, Statutes of 2022

SB 1321 (Ochoa Bogh) Public Contracts: Goods and Services

Requires a state agency in soliciting bids to address a need arising from a state of emergency declared by the Governor, to provide a mechanism for bidders to self-identify as a bidder whose headquarters are in the US and who manufacture their goods or provide services primarily in California.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Appropriations Committee

SB 1328 (McGuire) Prohibited Investments and Contracts: Russia and Belarus

Prohibits the pension funds and other state agencies from transacting with, investing in, or contracting with Russia and Belarus.

Last Action: Held in Assembly Public Employment and Retirement Committee

SB 1387 (Limon) Gubernatorial Appointments: Report

Requires the office of the Governor to maintain on its internet website a list of every state board and commission, their membership list, the stated purpose, duties, meeting frequency, and internet website of every state board and commission, and any vacancies in the membership of each state board and commission.

Last Action: Vetoed 09/29/2022

SB 1422 (Hertzberg) Acquisition of Goods and Services: Alternative Contracting Procedures: Installation of Carpet, Resilient Flooring, Synthetic Turf, and Lighting Fixtures: Pilot

Authorizes, until January 1, 2028, the Director of the Department of General Services to utilize existing consolidated procurement procedures for the purchase and installation of carpet, resilient flooring, synthetic turf or lighting fixtures and authorizes a state or local agency to contract with such a supplier, without further competitive bidding, if the project's contractor complies with skilled and trained labor requirements, amongst other requirements.

Last Action: Chapter 310, Statutes of 2022

SCR 70 (Caballero) The Mario Obledo Building

Designates the East End Complex-Block 171, located at 1501 Capitol Avenue in Sacramento, as the Mario Obledo Building.

Last Action: Chapter 177, Statutes of 2022
